

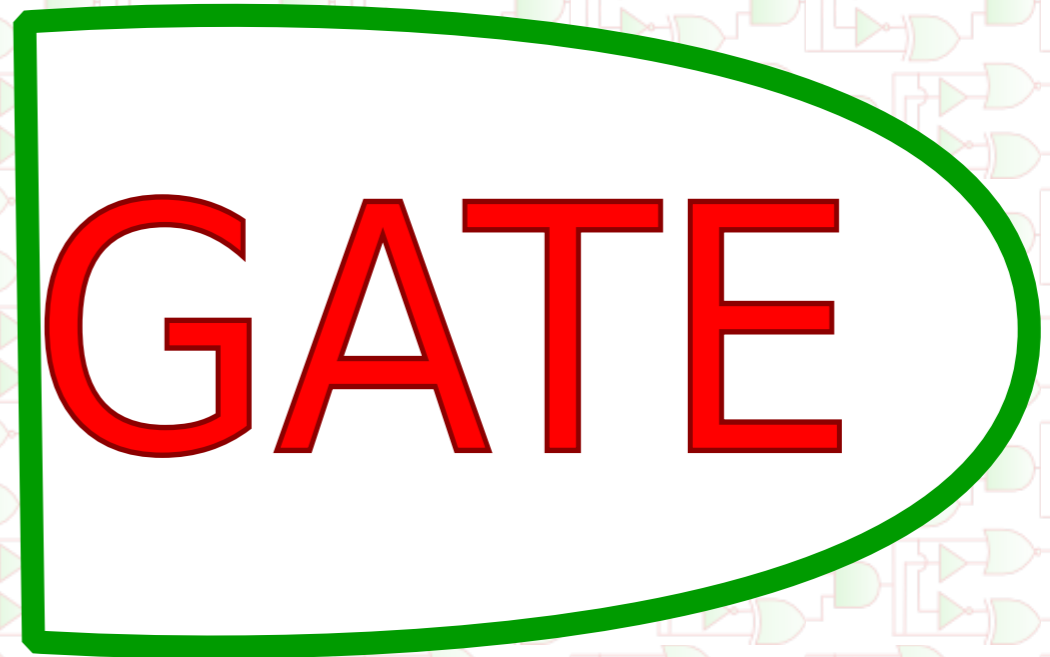
## Text Processing with GATE (Version 6)
